FACTS	WHAT DOES HOMESearchFINDER DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
WHY?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
WHAT?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social Security number and Income ▪ Credit History and Credit Scores ▪ Mortgage rates and payments and Employment Information When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
HOW?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Home Search Finder chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

WHAT WE DO	
How does HomeSearchFinder protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We restrict access to your information to those who have a legitimate business purpose, and we train employees on data security and confidentiality.
How does HomeSearchFinder collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Apply for a loan ■ Give us your income information or give us your contact information ■ Provide employment information and/or employment history ■ Show your government issued-ID and/or driver's license <p>We also collect your personal information from other companies, such as credit bureaus, during the loan application process.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
DEFINITIONS	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ HomeSearchFinder has no affiliates
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ HomeSearchFinder does not share with non-affiliates
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ HomeSearchFinder does not jointly market

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

California residents: In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of our corporation, except as permitted by law, including, for example, with your consent or to service your loan. We will limit sharing among our corporation to the extent required by California law*. For the complete California Consumer Privacy Act Notice.

North Dakota residents: In accordance with NDCC section 6-08.1-04, we will not share personal information with non-affiliates either for them to market you or for joint marketing, without your authorization*.

Vermont residents: Vermont is an "opt-in" state and in accordance with state law, we will not share non-public personal financial information, credit reports and/or creditworthiness information about you with other companies unless permitted by law, or to service your loan, or unless you specifically consent to sharing*.

*Accounts with a California, North Dakota or Vermont mailing address are automatically treated as if they have limited the sharing of information as described on page 1, unless you specifically opt-in to information sharing.

Nevada residents: Nevada Statute Section 228.600(3) allows marketing calls to our existing customers listed on the National Do Not Call Registry.
